

#### WHENYOUWILLGETYOURRESULTS

You will receive a letter via USPS with your examination results within 4vee 4s of taking the examination. The Commission does not give test score by emailor by phone. Yours core reports will detail your performance on the major areas of the examination, and whether you passed the examination.

If you pass the examination you will also received etails on how to complete the certification process. If you do not pass the examination you will receive details on how to retake the examination in the future, and a summary of the appeals process if you disagree with the score.

#### **APPEALS**

You may appeal any adverse decision made by the Commission, such as being denied permission to take the examination, or being denied a passing score on the examination. All appeals are reviewed by an independent appeals panel.


A small appeal fee applies to all appeal requests, but this fee is refunded if the appeal is decided in your favor.
